ARTICLE IV

The Rights, Responsibilities and Privileges of the General Board

Section B

As currently written

“The members of the General Board will have the power to serve on behalf of the congregation in all matters not specifically reserved to the congregation. A quorum of the General Board will be 15 of the eligible board members”.

Change to;

“The members of the General Board will have the power to serve on behalf of the congregation in all matters not specifically reserved to the congregation. A quorum of the General Board will be calculated by counting the occupied eligible voting positions and multiplying by 60%. A person holding two or more voting eligible positions will only be counted once. The result will be rounded up if the remainder is .5 or above and rounded down if it is .4 or below. (An example, 22 voting eligible positions, 17 are occupied, 2 people occupy more than one position. $17-2 \times .6 = 9$ is a quorum.)

This revision applies to the FCC Constitution, Article IV, Section B

The same wording was approved for FCC Bylaws Article II, Section B
